Present law authorizes the Board of Pharmacy to provide prescription monitoring information to prescription monitoring programs in other states. Proposed law retains present law and provides further authority for the board to provide prescription monitoring information to electronic health information systems and pharmacy information systems located in other states, territories, federal districts, and federal jurisdictions.

Proposed law makes technical corrections and clarifies that prescription monitoring information provided pursuant to present law may only be used in a manner consistent with present law.
