EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures for the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Corrections Services if a person is convicted of terrorizing of a judge or law enforcement officer. The maximum imprisonment term is fifteen years with or without hard labor. The number of individuals that may be convicted under the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> is indeterminable.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$60.09 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$24.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$21,992.03 (\$60.09 per day x 366 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,926.74 (\$24.39 per day x 366 days) if housed in a local facility.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in Local Funds revenue as a result of potential fines if a person is convicted of terrorizing of a judge or law enforcement officer. The maximum fine is \$15,000. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority. The potential net effect on sentencing decisions cannot be determined and the potential revenue impact is therefore unknown.
