**Abstract:** Establishes a motor vehicle inspection tax.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes an annual \$10 motor vehicle inspection tax for all motor vehicles not required to obtain a certificate of inspection pursuant to R.S. 32:1301 through 1306.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor vehicles to retain \$1.25 tax and remit the remaining \$8.75 to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state police for use in traffic enforcement.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the secretary to adopt rules and regulations to implement the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>, including, but not limited to, rules governing collection by the office of motor vehicles and remittance to the office of state police.

Effective if and when the Act which originated as House Bill 546 of the 2019 Regular Session of the Legislature becomes effective.
