



1           WHEREAS, at the April 10, 2019, Revenue Estimating Conference meeting the  
2 revenue estimate for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 was increased by \$119.3 million; and

3           WHEREAS, the state is in a better financial situation and no longer needs the  
4 additional .45% of state sales and use taxes collected from the citizens of this state, who  
5 deserve a break from state sales and use taxes.

6           THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana hereby suspends  
7 the provisions of R.S. 47:321.1 that provides for the levy of forty-five hundredth of one  
8 percent of state sales and use taxes.

9           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this suspension shall become effective upon  
10 adoption of this Resolution and shall extend through the sixtieth day after final adjournment  
11 of the 2020 Regular Session of the Legislature of Louisiana.
