Abstract: Exempts from the Public Records Law information relative to certain activities associated with the stocking and breeding of alligators.

Present law provides for an exemption from the Public Records Law information received by the Dept. of Wildlife and Fisheries related to shipment of alligator or alligator skins. Provides that aggregate statistical reports that do not reveal individual sources of information may be released to the public by the department.

Proposed law additionally exempts from the Public Records Law information related to activities associated with the egg collection, stocking, captive breeding, or farming inventory of alligators. Retains the ability for the department to release aggregate statistical reports that do not reveal individual sources of information.
