23 On page 3, after line 7, add the following:

24 "Section 3. It is the purpose of this Act to ensure absolute
25 confidentiality of any documents, records, or information that could lead to
26 the identification of a person or entity involved in any way in the Department
27 of Public Safety and Correction's acquisition or preparation of drugs for
28 lethal injections. It is necessary that the confidentiality provisions of this Act
29 be construed as broadly as possible to ensure the absolute confidentiality of
30 this identifying information so as to ensure that the Department of Public
31 Safety and Corrections is able to acquire the drugs necessary for lethal
32 injections."
