ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: Provides for use by licensed retail dealers of a real-time age verification system authorized by the commissioner

4	alcoholic beverages; to provide licensed retail dealers of alcoholic beverages an
5	alternative method of verifying age; and to provide for related matters.

8	paragraph) and (1)(a) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§90. Acts prohibited on licensed premises; suspension or revocation of permits
10	A. No person holding a retail dealer's permit, and no person permitted to sell
11	alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers, and no agent, associate, employee,
12	representative, or servant of any such person shall do or permit any of the following
13	acts to be done on or about the licensed premises:
14	(1)(a) Sell or serve alcoholic beverages to any person under the age of
15	twenty-one years, unless such person submits any one of the following means of
16	identification or a similar means of verification provided through use of a real-time
17	age verification system authorized by the commissioner:

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Abstract: Provides alternative means of verifying that a person is 21 years of age or older for the purpose of selling or serving alcoholic beverages, and prohibits certain acts on the licensed premises of a person permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits a person holding a retail dealer's permit, and any agent, associate, employee, representative, or servant of such person, to do or permit certain acts on or about the licensed premises.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends the application of the <u>present law</u> prohibitions to persons permitted to sell alcoholic beverages at retail to consumers.

<u>Present law</u> further provides for a list of certain types of identification to be used for verifying the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains the <u>present law</u> list and authorizes the use of a real-time age verification system authorized by the commissioner of ATC to verify the age of persons when selling or serving alcoholic beverages.
