Bishop

<u>Present law</u> creates a political subdivision of the state known as the Gentilly Development District, in the parish of Orleans.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the district to be governed by a six-member board of commissioners. Further provides that a majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but increases the membership of the board <u>from</u> six <u>to</u> seven.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds the state senator who represents Senate District No. 4, or his designee to the board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
