

1 (1) A member of the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs
2 designated by the chairman of the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs.

3 (2) A member of the Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs
4 designated by the chairman of the Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs.

5 (3) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare, or his designee.

6 (4) The chairman of the House Committee on Health and Welfare, or his designee.

7 (5) The chairman of the House Committee on Commerce, or his designee.

8 (6) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and
9 International Affairs, or his designee.

10 (7) A representative of the Louisiana Association of Business and Industry
11 designated by the president of the association.

12 (8) A representative of the division of administrative law designated by the director
13 of the division.

14 (9) A representative of the Pelican Institute designated by the chief executive officer
15 of the institute.

16 (10) A representative of the Department of Justice, civil division designated by the
17 attorney general.

18 (11) A representative of the Office of the State Register designated by the
19 commissioner of administration.

20 (12) A representative of the Department of Environmental Quality designated by the
21 secretary of the department.

22 (13) A representative of the National Federation of Independent Businesses
23 designated by the Louisiana state director.

24 (14) A representative of the Louisiana Chemical Association designated by the
25 president of the association.

26 (15) A representative of the Louisiana Oil and Gas Association designated by the
27 president of the association.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in conducting such study, the task force may
29 study and compare rulemaking practices of other states and of the federal government to
30 identify best practices.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that members of this task force shall serve without
2 compensation, except per diem or expense reimbursement to which they may be individually
3 entitled to as members of the constituent organizations.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the names of the members selected to serve on
5 the task force shall be submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives no later than
6 July 1, 2019.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall hold its organizational
8 meeting at the call of the member of the House Committee on House and Governmental
9 Affairs designated by the chairman of the House Committee on House and Governmental
10 Affairs and at its organizational meeting, the task force shall elect a chair and such other
11 officers as it deems necessary.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force may conduct such meetings at
13 such times as it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and
14 effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this
15 resolution.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall make a report of its findings
17 and recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, to the legislature
18 no later than January 1, 2020, at which time the task force shall cease to exist.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the
20 chairman of the House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs, the chairman of the
21 Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs, the chairman of the Senate
22 Committee on Health and Welfare; the chairman of the House Committee on Health and
23 Welfare, the chairman of the House Committee on Commerce, the chairman of the Senate
24 Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs, the president of
25 the Louisiana Association of Business and Industry, the director of the division of
26 administrative law, the chief executive officer of the Pelican Institute, the attorney general,
27 the commissioner of administration, the secretary of the Department of Environmental
28 Quality, the Louisiana state director of the National Federation of Independent Businesses,
29 the president of the Louisiana Chemical Association, and the president of the Louisiana Oil
30 and Gas Association.
