2	To recognize Tuesday, May 14, 2019, as Louisiana Music Advocacy Day at the state capitol.
3	WHEREAS, music and its creators are among Louisiana's greatest natural and
4	renewable resources; and
5	WHEREAS, Louisiana has influenced and inspired many of the world's musical
6	styles, including jazz, blues, zydeco, swamp pop, rock & roll, gospel, country, bounce,
7	rhythm & blues, and Cajun music; and
8	WHEREAS, Louisiana's musicians, including many Grammy nominees and winners,
9	create an environment conducive to continued innovation in music; and
10	WHEREAS, the Louisiana music industry is an economic driver which,
11	unfortunately, has not received the same level of recognition as food, tourism, agriculture,
12	manufacturing, and other sectors for contributions to the economy of the state; and
13	WHEREAS, in a state where tourism is one of the largest industries, music is
14	regarded as one of the primary attractions that causes visitors to come to Louisiana; and
15	WHEREAS, Louisiana has numerous postsecondary educational programs devoted
16	to educating future musicians and music industry professionals; and
17	WHEREAS, it is essential that Louisiana recognize the economic importance of
18	Louisiana's music industry and incentivize growth of the industry's support system so as to
19	nurture careers in the music industry.
20	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
21	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize Tuesday, May 14, 2019, as Louisiana Music
