10 31, 2020.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
12 secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health, the executive director of the governor's
13 office of disability affairs, and the executive director of the Louisiana Developmental
14 Disabilities Council.
