Requires public school governing authorities to establish local special education advisory councils. (gov sig)

<u>Proposed legislation</u> requires each public school governing authority to create a special education advisory council to provide advice and feedback regarding special education policies, procedures, and resources. The number of members shall be determined by the governing authority; 50% shall be parents of students with exceptionalities, 25% shall be teachers, principals, paraprofessionals, and 25% shall be other stakeholders. Requires the councils to meet at least three times a year and to make a report to the school governing authority in May of each year. Effective upon governor's signature.
