RACING/HORSE: Provides relative to the Horsemen's Bookkeeper

6	Section 1. R.S. 3:2438.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8	"Horse aftercare" means the providing for the retraining or retiring of
9	thoroughbreds and quarter horses that have participated at licensed race tracks in
10	Louisiana.

16	(3)(a) Except for interest earned on the investment of monies in the

20	withdrawals from the account shall be only for those purposes provided in Paragraph

However, monies generated from donations to horse 2 aftercare, as defined in R.S. 3:2438.1, reserves administered by the representative of 3 horsemen in the state shall be authorized for withdrawals and disbursement from the 4 Horsemen's Bookkeeper Account. 5 (b) Pursuant to this Paragraph, the horse aftercare reserves shall be managed, 6 at all times, by the representative of horsemen in the state and is to be funded by 7 donations and, in part, by a five dollar automatic donation per start. The five dollar 8 automatic donation per start may be withdrawn, or opted out of, by providing written 9 notification to the representative of horsemen in the state. 10

**Abstract:** Relative to horse racing, provides for authorization for withdrawals and disbursement from the Horsemen's Bookkeeper Account

Proposed law defines "horse aftercare".

<u>Present law</u> provides that except for interest earned on the investment of monies in the Horsemen's Bookkeeper Account (the account) and that portion of a pony lead fee as authorized and assessed by the representative of horsemen in the state to provide retirement benefits to horsemen and pay its administrative and operating costs. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds the requirement that the monies generated from donations to the horse after care reserves administered by the representatives of horsemen in the state be authorized for withdrawals and disbursement from the account.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires that the horse aftercare reserves be managed by the representative of the horsemen in the state.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the horse aftercare reserves be funded by donation and, in part, by a \$5.00 automatic donation per start.

<u>Proposed law</u> allows the \$5.00 automatic donation per start to be withdrawn or opted out of by written notification to the representative of horsemen in the state.
