
SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senator Chabert to Reengrossed House Bill No. 349 by Representative Carmody

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 3, line 17, after "party" insert "or its agent"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 4, line 23, after "Form W-2" delete the period "." and insert "or an independent
5 contractor for which the third party shall be required to file and Internal Revenue Service
6 Form 1099. For purposes of this Section, the employee or independent contractor that makes
7 a delivery on behalf of the third party may also be referred to as a "third party delivery
8 agent" or "agent.""

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 5, line 13, after "(3)" delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:

11 "The third party shall not be the holder of a permit for alcoholic beverage
12 wholesale dealer, manufacturer, winery, or supplier. The third party shall not hold
13 an interest in a permit for alcoholic beverage wholesale dealer, manufacturer, winery,
14 or supplier.

15 (4) The third party delivery shall maintain a general liability"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 5, between lines 16 and 17, add the following:

18 "The third party shall be vicariously liable for its agent's violations of this
19 Title and administrative rules promulgated thereunder, and for damages caused by
20 its agent in connection with the delivery of alcoholic beverages."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 5

22 On page 5, line 17, change "(4)" to "(6)" and change "employees" to "agents"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 6

24 On page 5, line 19, change "(5)" to "(7)"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 7

26 On page 5, line 23, after "party may" delete "act as an agent of" and insert "assist"

27 AMENDMENT NO. 8

28 On page 6, delete lines 19 through 22
