KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

ROADS/HIGHWAYS. Provides for addition of "Home of the Who Dat Nation Highway" signs on I-10 in Louisiana and designates portions of La. Hwy 90 to La. Hwy 308 as the "Governor Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Highway". (8/1/19)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Adds designation of U.S. Hwy 90 from its intersection with I-10 in Lafayette to its intersection with La. Hwy 308 in Raceland as the "Governor Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Highway".

Requires DOTD to add "Home of the Who Dat Nation" signs to Louisiana welcome signs on I-10 in Louisiana at the Texas and Mississippi State Lines and in downtown New Orleans at the exit to the Superdome.

Designates U.S. Hwy 90 from its intersection with I-10 in Lafayette to its intersection with La. Hwy No. 308 in Raceland as the "Governor Kathleen Babineaux Blanco Highway".

Directs DOTD to erect and maintain signs provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed \$1,100 per sign.

Effective August 1, 2019.
