3	over politics has merited his consistent reelection to office since 1996; and

5	sides of an argument, to treat all stakeholders with respect, and to work across party lines
6	to accomplish goals to benefit the people of his district and the state; and
7	WHEREAS, he has served on both the senate and house insurance committees where
8	he crafted legislation to protect the rights of both the insured and the insurance companies,
