2	To enact R.S. 33:2212(I), relative to the city of Houma; to provide relative to the salaries of
3	certain members of the police department; to provide for an increase in salary for
4	such members; to provide for the calculation of longevity pay; and to provide for
5	related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
7	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of
8	Louisiana.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 33:2212(I) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§2212. Minimum salaries; increases
12	* * *
13	I. On and after July 1, 2019, each member of the police department of the
14	city of Houma who has completed three years of continuous service shall receive an
15	increase in salary of two percent and shall thereafter receive an increase in salary of
16	two percent for each additional year of service. The base pay, the accrued longevity,
17	and state supplemental pay shall be used in computing longevity pay.
18	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019; if vetoed by the governor
19	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
20	2019, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
