AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 56:251(A)(2)(a)(i) and to repeal R.S. 56:251(A)(2)(a)(ii),
3	relative to hunting alligators; to require an alligator hunting license in order to take
4	an alligator; to eliminate the additional license for an assistant to an alligator hunter;
5	and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 56:251(A)(2)(a)(i) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§251. Licenses; possession limit for nonresident alligator hunter; deposit as
10	guarantee of payment of severance tax; penalties
11	A. The following license fees shall be levied on each fur trapper, alligator
12	hunter, fur buyer, and fur dealer:
13	* * *
14	(2)(a)(i) Every resident alligator hunter shall before commencing business
15	procure annually from the department a resident alligator hunting license, which
16	shall be furnished upon payment of twenty-five dollars, and the filing of an
17	application approved by the department. Every nonresident alligator hunter shall
18	before commencing business procure annually from the department a nonresident
19	alligator hunter license, which shall be furnished upon the payment of one hundred
20	fifty dollars, and the filing of an application approved by the department. Every
21	resident and nonresident alligator hunter must at all times have this license in
22	possession while hunting or taking alligators.
