A RESOLUTION

To commend the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) upon the one hundred year anniversary of its Baton Rouge branch.

WHEREAS, the NAACP's principal objectives are:

- To ensure the political, educational, social, and economic equality of all citizens.
- To achieve equality of rights and eliminate race prejudice among the citizens of the United States.
