5 learned of the death of Rodney L. Braxton on June 3, 2019, at the age of ninety; and

6 WHEREAS, Rodney Louis Braxton was born on July 1, 1928, in New Orleans,
7 Louisiana, and was a resident of Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and

8 WHEREAS, he served in the Army Air Corps and was a graduate of Xavier
9 University of Louisiana; and
