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HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 320

TRANSPORTATION DEPT: Urges and requests the Department of Transportation and Development to dedicate a portion of the economic damage proceeds from the Deepwater Horizon litigation to Northeast Louisiana

A RESOLUTION

2	To urge and request the Department of Transportation and Development to dedicate the
3	economic damage proceeds from the Deepwater Horizon litigation allocated to the
4	On-System Bridge Program for replacement and rehabilitation program for highway
5	bridges on any federal-aid system over waterways, other topographical barriers, other
6	highways, and railroads and for replacement and rehabilitation of highway bridges
7	on state highways that are ineligible for federal highway funding assistance to
8	Northeast Louisiana.
9	WHEREAS, the Deepwater Horizon oil spill leaked four million one hundred
10	thousand barrels of oil into the Gulf of Mexico making it the worst spill in United States
11	history; and
12	WHEREAS, the economic impact of the spill was far reaching affecting the fishing
13	and tourism industries and requiring several billion dollars in clean-up costs; and
14	WHEREAS, Louisiana has received the largest amount of reparation payments to
15	compensate for economic damage and lost income, almost two billion six hundred thirty-six
16	thousand dollars; and
17	WHEREAS, the Deepwater Horizon Economic Damages Collection Fund was
18	established in the state treasury as a special permanent trust fund; and

1	WHEREAS, all economic damages proceeds from the Deepwater Horizon litigation
2	in excess of the first two hundred million dollars deposited in the Fiscal Year 2015-2016
3	Deficit Elimination Fund shall be deposited by the state treasurer; and
4	WHEREAS, beginning July 1, 2021, and each fiscal year thereafter through and
5	including Fiscal Year 2034, in such amounts as remain after payment of amounts due on
6	bonds and related expenses as provided in the documents pursuant to which bonds were
7	issued, the state treasurer is required to immediately transfer the annual payments of fifty-
8	three million three hundred thirty-three thousand three hundred thirty-three dollars to the
9	Construction Subfund of the Transportation Trust Fund; and
10	WHEREAS, the economic damage proceeds and the bonds issued by the State Bond
11	Commission shall be issued, after paying the costs associated with the issuance of the bonds,
12	solely and exclusively for certain projects in specified amounts; and
13	WHEREAS, twenty-five million dollars per year, for a total of one hundred fifty
14	million dollars, was dedicated to Phase Two of the Louisiana 1 Improvement Project
15	between Golden Meadow, Louisiana and Leeville, Louisiana for Fiscal Years 2021-2026;
16	and
17	WHEREAS, one hundred twenty-five million dollars was dedicated to the Louisiana
18	415 Bridge at the Intracoastal Canal; and
19	WHEREAS, one hundred fifty million dollars was dedicated to Interstate 49 South;
20	and
21	WHEREAS, fifty million dollars was dedicated to Louisiana Highway 3241 from
22	Interstate 12 to Bush, Louisiana; and
23	WHEREAS, one hundred million dollars was dedicated to the construction of two
24	additional lanes for the Jimmy Davis Bridge (Louisiana Highway 511) and repair of the
25	existing bridge; and
26	WHEREAS, twenty million dollars was dedicated to the acquisition of a new
	Cameron Parish ferry; and

2728	WHEREAS, forty million dollars was dedicated to the On-System Bridge Program
	WHEREAS, forty million dollars was dedicated to the On-System Bridge Program for the replacement and rehabilitation program for highway bridges on any federal-aid

1 replacement and rehabilitation of highway bridges on state highways that are ineligible for 2 federal highway funding assistance; and 3 WHEREAS, nineteen million dollars was dedicated to Phase I and II of the 4 Sugarhouse Road Extension/Eddie Williams Boulevard to Louisiana Highway 43 Highway 5 1 project; and 6 WHEREAS, twenty million dollars was dedicated to the acquisition of two cranes 7 for the Port of New Orleans; and 8 WHEREAS, fifteen million dollars was dedicated to the Hooper Road Widening 9 from Louisiana Highway 3034 to Louisiana Highway 37; and 10 WHEREAS, a portion of the economic damage proceeds were allocated to benefit 11 a project in every area of the state, except Northeast Louisiana; and 12 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Development should dedicate the 13 forty million dollars of economic damage proceeds allocated to the On-System Bridge 14 Program for replacement and rehabilitation program for highway bridges on any federal-aid 15 system over waterways, other topographical barriers, other highways, and railroads and for 16 replacement and rehabilitation of highway bridges on state highways that are ineligible for 17 federal highway funding assistance to Northeast Louisiana to ensure the infrastructure needs 18 of that area of the state are addressed. 19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 20 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Transportation and 21 Development to dedicate the forty million dollars of the economic damage proceeds from 22 the Deepwater Horizon litigation allocated to the On-System Bridge Program for 23 replacement and rehabilitation program for highway bridges on any federal-aid system over 24 waterways, other topographical barriers, other highways, and railroads and for replacement 25 and rehabilitation of highway bridges on state highways that are ineligible for federal 26 highway funding assistance to Northeast Louisiana. 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the 28 secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development.
