<u>Prior law</u>, relative to mayor's court, authorized the mayor to impose court costs not to exceed \$30 for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

<u>New law</u> provides that notwithstanding <u>prior law</u>, the mayor of the town of Livingston may impose court costs not to exceed \$50 dollars for each offense on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

Effective upon signature of the governor (June 11, 2019).
