Prior law required an applicant for the certified medication attendant drug administration training course to be a citizen of the United States and a resident of Louisiana. New law clarifies and expands the citizenship requirement to allow for a citizen of the United States, a United States national, or an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residency in the United States. New law repeals the state residency requirement. New law retains the additional eligibility requirements for acceptance into the drug administration course set forth in prior law.

New law makes technical corrections to the eligibility requirements retained from prior law.

Effective August 1, 2019.
