<u>Existing law</u> provides immediate family members of the following law enforcement officers with the right to purchase the officer's firearm:

- (1) All sheriffs and deputy sheriffs in the state employed on a full-time basis.
- (2) All members of the state police.
- (3) All municipal police officers employed on a full-time basis.

<u>Prior law</u> restricted the right to purchase the firearm to circumstances in which the officer died as a result of an injury arising out of and in the course of the performance of his official duties as a law enforcement officer.

<u>New law</u> expands the <u>existing law</u> list of law enforcement officers to include university and college police officers at state universities and colleges. <u>New law</u> also eliminates the <u>prior law</u> requirement that the officer be killed in the line of duty in order for the immediate family member to be able to purchase the firearm.

Effective August 1, 2019.
