<u>Existing law</u> allows for anyone who meets the legal requirements of a justice of the peace to be appointed as a justice of the peace ad hoc.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> and further allows a justice of the peace currently elected from the same parish as the presiding justice of the peace to be appointed as an ad hoc.

<u>Prior law</u> required a justice of the peace ad hoc to be paid the same compensation as the presiding justice of the peace.

<u>New law</u> amends <u>prior law</u> to authorize, instead of require, an ad hoc justice of the peace to be paid the same compensation as the presiding justice of the peace.

Effective August 1, 2019.
