Existing law authorizes police juries to create sewerage districts composed of territory outside the corporate limits of municipalities.

Existing law requires the police jury to appoint at least three but no more than five property taxpayers residing within the district as the district's board of supervisors. Provides exceptions for district governance.

New law provides an additional exception for parishes governed by home rule charters, excluding Orleans Parish. Authorizes these parishes to provide, by ordinance, for the governance of districts they create. Provides that such ordinances may provide for the creation of one or more supervising boards and shall provide for the appointment and compensation of members of any supervising board created.

Effective August 1, 2019.
