## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

Existing law authorizes a school board, during the reapportionment process, to reestablish its membership with at least five but not more than 15 members. Provides that when the size of a school board is to be changed by reapportionment, the school board may submit the proposition of size to the people.

New law requires a school board in a parish with a population of between 90,000 and 105,000 persons to reestablish itself, by majority vote, with not less than five nor more than nine members. Further adds that when the size of a school board is to be changed by reapportionment, the school board may submit the proposition of size to the people.
