<u>New law</u> prohibits a political subdivision, when filling an employment position, from inquiring about a prospective employee's arrest record on the initial application form. Provides that <u>new law</u> does not prohibit a political subdivision from inquiring about a prospective employee's other criminal history on an initial application form. Exempts employment positions for which a background check is required by law from new law.

Effective August 1, 2019.
