<u>Prior law</u> authorized the fire marshal to pay a fee of \$5 plus mileage for each structural fire report submitted by a volunteer fire department and defined volunteer fire department. <u>New law deletes prior law</u>.

<u>New law</u> requires that an organization obtain a fire department identification (FDID) number in order to engage in traditional fire department activities. <u>New law</u> further provides that if an organization fails to obtain an FDID number, it has violated <u>existing law</u> (R.S. 14:112.2), which prohibits the fraudulent portrayal of a law enforcement officer or firefighter.

<u>New law</u> prohibits the issuance of an FDID number to any organization not recognized by a local governing authority to conduct traditional fire department-related activities.

<u>Prior law</u> required that structural fire reports be submitted to the fire marshal as he prescribes on forms he creates. <u>New law</u> changes <u>prior law</u> to require that structural fire reports be submitted electronically by organizations which obtain an FDID number.

<u>Prior law</u> defined the terms "volunteer member" and "volunteer fire department". <u>New law</u> deletes those terms and defines "traditional fire department-related activities".

<u>Existing law</u> charges the Fire Marshal's Review Board to review investigation and inspection reports that the fire marshal prescribes. <u>New law</u> retains <u>existing law</u> substantively but changes the reference <u>from</u> "Fire Marshal's Review Board" <u>to</u> "board of review" for consistency in existing law (R.S. 40:1578.1).
