New law provides definitions for "forest product", "harvester", and "landowner".

<u>New law</u> requires a person who acquires forest products to pay the landowner in full within 30 days of receipt of payment for selling the products.

<u>New law</u> requires the landowner to send written notice demanding payment after the 30-day window and allows the harvester 10 additional days to make the payment in full before facing criminal penalties.

<u>New law</u> provides that the criminal penalties are dependent upon the value of forest products the harvester took without paying the landowner.

Effective Aug. 1, 2019.
