Abstract: Suspends the benefits of any member of the Firefighters' Retirement System (FRS) who returns to work with an employer covered by the system.

<u>Present law</u> provides that if a retiree from FRS returns to work in a full-time position covered by the system, payment of his retirement benefits ceases. <u>Proposed law</u> makes the requirement for cessation of benefits applicable to an FRS retiree who returns to work in a part-time position covered by the system.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the employee and employer contribute to the system during full-time reemployment and that the retirement option that was selected at the first retirement cannot be changed. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> applicable only to retirees who return to work in full-time positions.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
