Abstract: Exempts local governments from the prohibition on naming public buildings after living persons.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the naming of a public building or certain other public facilities owned by the state, by a local government, or by an institution receiving support from the state in honor of a living person.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> (HB _____) authorizes the governing authority of a local government to name a building or facility it owns after any living or deceased person.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts local governments from the prohibition in <u>present law</u>.

Effective if and when the proposed amendment of Article VI of the Constitution of La. contained in the Act which originated as House Bill No. ___ of this 2020 R.S. of the Legislature is adopted at a statewide election and becomes effective.
