**Abstract:** Changes which election sections the Division I and magistrate judges are elected from in the Fourteenth Judicial District.

Present law provides that the Fourteenth Judicial District Court shall have nine judges.

<u>Present law</u> provides that two judges (Divisions F and H) shall be elected from election section one, four judges (Divisions B, C, D, and G) shall be elected from election section two, two judges (Divisions A and E) shall be elected from election section three, and one judge (Division I) shall be elected from elected from election sections one and three combined.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the Fourteenth Judicial District shall have a magistrate judge who is elected from election sections one and three combined.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> except with regard to the election of the Division I judge, <u>proposed</u> <u>law</u> provides that one judge (Division I) be elected from election section one only instead of election sections one and three combined.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the election section the magistrate judge is elected from, providing that the magistrate judge be elected from election section one instead of election sections one and three combined.
