Abstract: Adopts daylight saving time as the year round standard time, in the event of a change in federal law.

Proposed law requires Louisiana to adopt daylight saving time year round, when the federal law is amended to allow it.

Proposed law provides that, if proposed law becomes effective when the state is observing daylight saving time, the state shall not return to the observance of standard time.

Proposed law provides that, if proposed law becomes effective when the state is observing standard time, then the state shall wait until 2:00 a.m. on the second Sunday in March to return to, and remain in, the observance of daylight saving time.
