



before the board for an oral interview.

Proposed law authorizes the board to adopt rules concerning eligibility for licensure of an individual who has failed an examination seven or more times.

Present law grants disciplinary and enforcement action to the board for certain acts and offenses committed by an officer, director, manager, employee, agent, or representative of a firm.

Proposed law retains present law and adds acts and offenses subject to disciplinary and enforcement actions by the board.

Effective August 1, 2020.
