Abstract: Allows an individual that has been convicted of a felony to participate in the Bail Bond Apprentice Program.

<u>Present law</u> establishes the Bail Bond Apprentice Program and requires participants to have the following qualifications:

(1) Meet the current bail bond producer licensing requirements.

(2) Not have been convicted of a felony.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the requirement that participants not have been convicted of a felony.
