SENATE BILL NO. 301

COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS. Prohibits the sale of vapor products with a characterizing flavor. (8/1/20)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 26:901(36) and 911(E), relative to vapor products; to provide for prohibitions;
3 to direct the Louisiana State Law Institute to arrange in alphabetical order and
4 renumber certain definitions; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 26:901(36) and 911(E) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §901. Definitions

8 As used in this Chapter, the following terms have the meaning ascribed to
9 them in this Section, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

11 **(36) "Characterizing flavor" means a distinguishable flavor, taste, or**
12 **aroma other than tobacco, mint, or menthol, including but not limited to any**
13 **fruit, chocolate, vanilla, honey, candy, cocoa, dessert, alcoholic beverage, herb,**
14 **wintergreen, or spice flavoring, that is imparted, prior to or during**
15 **consumption, by use of a vapor product including liquid nicotine, or any smoke**
16 **or vapor emanating from that device or product. A vapor product shall be**
17 **deemed to have a characterizing flavor if the product is advertised or marketed**
