Abstract: Increases the maximum age limit for constables from 70 years of age to 74 years of age.

<u>Present law</u> provides that beginning in the year 2008, to qualify to run for the office of constable, a person shall not have attained the age of 70 years by the date of qualification to run for office.

<u>Present law</u> further provides that a constable who attains 70 years of age while serving a term of office shall be allowed to complete that term of office.

<u>Present law</u> also provides that the <u>present law</u> provision shall not apply to those constables who are serving as a constable or who are elected to the office of constable on or before Aug. 15, 2006.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and changes the maximum age limit from 70 years of age to 74 years of age.
