Abstract: Provides relative to the quarterly reporting requirements of jail facilities to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections.

<u>Proposed law provides</u> for definitions for the following terms: "average daily population", "case disposition", "confined inmate", "hold", "jail facility", "jail management system", "municipal offense", "operational capacity", "sentenced inmate", and "unsentenced inmate".

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the keeper of each jail facility to keep and maintain a daily record of certain data provided for in <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires each jail facility to submit a quarterly report, beginning Jan. 15, 2021, to the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections through an electronic survey designed by the department.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if a jail facility fails to submit a quarterly report within 30 days after a reporting date, the jail facility is considered noncompliant for the reporting period. Requires the secretary of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to send a notice to the noncompliant jail facility.
