**Abstract:** Provides for changes to when a voter's registration may be cancelled.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the registration of a voter, who is on the inactive list, may not be cancelled unless the voter has been on the inactive list for a period of two regularly scheduled federal general elections.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the period that a voter must be on the inactive list, prior to having his registration cancelled, <u>from</u> two regularly scheduled federal general elections <u>to</u> four regularly scheduled federal general elections.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a voter's registration shall not be cancelled between any primary election and the subsequent general election, except in the case of a fraud or in the case of a person whose registration is cancelled pursuant to the annual canvass conducted by the registrar.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that notwithstanding <u>present law</u>, a voter on the inactive list may not have his registration cancelled within 120 days before an election in the jurisdiction where the voter was last registered.
