**Abstract:** Creates certificates of registration related to advanced esthetics.

Present law defines "esthetics". Proposed law retains present law in part, but adds language to distinguish between "esthetics" and "advanced esthetics".

Proposed law defines "advanced esthetics" and "advanced practice esthetics".

Present law authorizes the cosmetology board to offer certificates of registration for cosmetologists, estheticians, and manicurists.

Proposed law retains present law but adds a certificate of registration for advanced estheticians.

Present law authorizes the cosmetology board to offer certificates of registration for teachers of cosmetologists, estheticians, and manicurists.

Proposed law retains present law but adds a certificate of registration for teachers of advanced estheticians.

Present law authorizes cosmetology schools to offer continuing education in esthetics, containing not less than 200 hours of study.

Proposed law instead authorizes schools to offer a course of practical training and technical instruction in advanced esthetics containing not less than 250 hours of study.
