## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There will be an increase in revenue to local governmental agencies as a result of this measure.

Although the proposed legislation increases the penalties for hunting without a license, the Department of Wildlife & Fisheries (LDWF) will continue to receive the same portion of the penalty for their statutorily dedicated funds. LDWF receives \$5 of any fine for the Conservation Fund and \$2 of any fine for the Fish and Wildlife Reward Fund. Any increase in revenues resulting from the increase in penalties will be realized by local Sheriff's offices, District Attorney's offices, and/or other offices within the judicial system in a local municipality or parish. The increase in revenues is indeterminable at this time as the number of potential violators is unknown. The number of violations issued in the past three years are: 99 in 2017; 107 in 2018; and 103 in 2019. Violators must be convicted of the offense; therefore, LDWF may not realize revenues from all citations issued.
