

1 leader and motivator who shared his expertise with his coworkers, he placed particular
2 emphasis on the credo "to protect and to serve", he was always "on the job" twenty-four
3 hours per day, seven days per week, and well-respected by his fellow troopers; and

4 WHEREAS, as a native son of Bossier City, Steve Robinson graduated from Airline
5 High School in 1981 and later joined the Bossier Parish Sheriff's Office as a deputy for six
6 years with duties as a communications officer, patrolman, and narcotics investigator; and

7 WHEREAS, upon graduation from Louisiana State Police Academy, he was
8 commissioned as a trooper in 1990; and

9 WHEREAS, during his tenure with the Louisiana State Police, he was recognized for
10 his acumen in traffic accident reconstruction, SWAT (Special Weapons And Tactics)
11 operations, riverboat gaming investigations, criminal intelligence investigations, and patrol
12 supervision; and

13 WHEREAS, on May 6, 2016, Steve Robinson was commissioned as a State Police
14 Captain and was appointed as Commander of Louisiana State Police, Troop G; and

15 WHEREAS, his responsibilities included oversight and delivery of public safety
16 services in seven parishes throughout Northwest Louisiana, command of more than one
17 hundred commissioned troopers, and service as the liaison to all other public safety partners
18 that included local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies; and

19 WHEREAS, Steve faithfully discharged his duties until his retirement in September
20 2018, due to his illness; and

21 WHEREAS, Captain Robinson stepped down from command with no regrets having
22 served 28.5 years of outstanding service in the ranks of the Louisiana State Police; and

23 WHEREAS, Captain Robinson was recognized on many occasions for the
24 exceptional performance of his duty to safeguard life and property against violence and
25 disorder and of the leadership of those troopers under his command; and

26 WHEREAS, Trooper Steve Robinson was honored on behalf of a grateful nation with
27 an honor guard of fellow officers and a processional of brothers and sisters of The Thin Blue
28 Line who paid homage to their fallen comrade and escorted him to his final resting place at
29 Rose-Neath Cemetery in Bossier City; and

30 WHEREAS, Steve is survived by his devoted wife, DeAnna Parker Robinson; their
