Abstract: Provides relative to the training, registration, and certification of fire-stopping material applicators.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a training, registration, and certification process for fire-resistant material applicators.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "firestops" or "fire-stopping material".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a fire-stopping material applicator is a person who applies fire-stopping material. Further, <u>proposed law</u> requires that the fire-stopping material applicator obtain training in the application of fire-stopping materials according to manufacturer recommendations. <u>Proposed law</u> requires fire-stopping material applicators to register with the office of state fire marshal.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the state fire marshal to issue certificates to fire-stopping material applicators who have completed the training and registered with the state fire marshal.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes a fine of \$250 per violation for any person applying fire-stopping material without being certified.
