Luneau

Present law provides for qualifications of professional engineers in La.

<u>Proposed law</u>, beginning January 1, 2021, requires the La. Professional Engineering and Land Surveying Board (board) to waive the Fundamentals of Engineering examination if the applicant satisfies the following:

- (1) Is a graduate of an accredited engineering curriculum of four years or more approved by the board as being of satisfactory standing.
- (2) Has 20 years or more of progressive engineering experience in work acceptable to the board.
- (3) Is of good character and reputation.
- (4) Has passed the Principles and Practice of Engineering examination.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the board to adopt rules in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act by January 1, 2021.

Effective August 1, 2020.
