AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 4, after "meets;" delete "to provide for satisfaction of requirements;" and insert in lieu thereof "to provide for a contingent effective date;"

- 2 On page 2, delete lines 16 through 22 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 "Section 3. This Act shall become effective if and when the Class Action Settlement 4 Agreement in the lawsuit Soileau v. Churchill Downs La. Horseracing Co., Parish of Orleans, Civil District Court, Division G, No. 2014-3873, is approved by the Court and 5 becomes final and non-appealable. Contingent upon this approval, as confirmed by a final 6 7 and non-appealable judgment, any amounts of purses from net video draw poker device revenue collected but not yet distributed on the date the amended statute is made effective 8 9 shall be allocated and distributed according to the amended statute, using the same formula 10 provided therein."
