On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 15:574.2(D)(1)" delete the remainder of the line and insert "and to enact R.S. 15:574.7(E), relative to the committee on parole;"

#### 12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

- "(1) Except as provided in Paragraph (C)(4) of this Section, to To determine
  the time and conditions of release on parole of any offender"

#### 16 AMENDMENT NO. 6

- 17 On page 1, line 18, after "state" and before the period "." insert a comma "," and "<u>in</u> 18 accordance with R.S. 15:574.7"
- 19 AMENDMENT NO. 7
- 20 On page 1, after line 19, add the following:

21	"§574.7. Custody and supervision of parolees; modification or suspension of
22	supervision; violation of conditions of parole; sanctions; alternative
23	conditions; administrative sanctions

E. Upon recommendation of the supervising parole officer and approval of
 the committee on parole, the level of supervision and the fees associated with the
 supervision of a parolee may be reduced after the parolee has served a minimum of
 five years without a violation of the terms and conditions of parole for a crime that
 is not a crime of violence as defined by R.S. 14:2(B) and a minimum of seven years
 for a crime that is a crime of violence as defined by R.S. 14:2(B)."
