**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 105 by Representative Zeringue

1    AMENDMENT NO. 1

2    In the set of committee amendments (No. 2408) adopted by the House Committee on  
3    Appropriations on May 21, 2020, delete amendment no. 123.

4    AMENDMENT NO. 2

5    On page 65, between lines 22 and 23, insert in lieu thereof:

6    "Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Louisiana Department of  
7    Health shall check income eligibility utilizing a three-month rolling average income for  
8    all enrollees in the Medicaid program. Beginning in October, the Louisiana Department  
9    of Health shall submit a report each month to the Joint Legislative Committee on the  
10   Budget certifying that one hundred percent of the Medicaid enrollee population has been  
11   subject to an eligibility check within the last three months. The report shall include the  
12   number of enrollees found ineligible, the number of enrollees disenrolled, and the  
13   number of people re-enrolled after disenrollment within the last three months.

14   Notwithstanding any provision of law or this Act to the contrary, once the federal  
15   disenrollment restrictions relative to increased Federal Medical Assistance Percentage  
16   have been lifted, if enrollees do not meet eligibility requirements within thirty days of the  
17   eligibility check, no additional funds herein appropriated or authorized later through a  
18   BA-7 in any means of finance may be used for Medicaid services for any enrollee failing  
19   to meet the eligibility standards financially. After becoming ineligible, an applicant has  
20   thirty days to appeal their claim of disenrollment."
