EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Discussions with Office of Group Benefits staff indicate they will utilize the existing contract with their actuarial services provider (Buck Global, LLC) to conduct the study contemplated in the resolution. For reference, the contract with Buck Global has enumerated services covered and is a funded on a flat monthly fee basis, regardless of services provided as long as they fall within the scope of the contract. Staff at OGB report that the study requested by the proposed resolution falls within the existing contract's scope of services, and will therefore present no additional cost.

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
