Abstract: Provides that unintentional acts or omissions by organ procurement organizations towards a donor of an anatomical gift is considered medical malpractice.

<u>Present law</u> does not provide for acts or omissions by organ procurement organizations in private services or state services to be considered medical malpractice.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to include organ procurement organizations' acts or omissions in both private and state services.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends the definition of "patient" in <u>present law</u> to include a donor or prospective donor of an organ or tissue.
